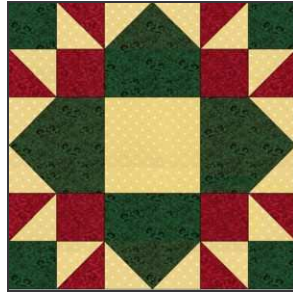


Holiday Cheer

(9" x 9" Finished Size)



Here's a block adapted from one called Weathervane that was published in the Kansas City Star in the 1930s. I made a couple of changes to it to come up with this one using holiday colors. I hope you enjoy this.

Dark Red (Burgundy) – Cut four 2" squares.

Cut four 2 3/8" squares. Cut each 2 3/8" square into two triangles for a total of eight triangles.

Dark Green (Forest Green) – Cut four 2" squares.

Cut four 3 1/2" squares.

Light Beige – Cut eight 2" squares.

Cut four 2 3/8" squares. Cut each 2 3/8" square into two triangles for a total of eight triangles.

Cut one 3 1/2" square.

For each Dark Green 3 1/2" square – These will be used for each side. Mark diagonal line on each 2" Light Beige square on wrong side of fabric. Place one Light Beige 2" square on left corner of one Dark Green 3 1/2" square. Stitch on diagonal line. Trim seam to 1/4". Press open to form Light Beige triangle on corner of Dark Green square. Do the same with the right side of the Dark Green square.

Assemble the rest of the block using your preferred method following picture.
