

SANTIAM SCRAPPERS BOM for September, 2004

(8" x 8" Finished Size)



Prairie Diamonds

Dark Brown (DB)

- 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles – cut 4
- 2 7/8" squares – cut 6

Light Beige or Light Brown (LB)

- 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles – cut 4
- 2 7/8" squares – cut 6

NOTE: All squares need to be 2 1/2". Be sure to measure and trim as needed before assembling the block.

Half-Square Triangle (HST) Squares

- Use the 2 7/8" squares.
- Draw a line diagonally from one corner to the opposite corner on the wrong sides of the 6 Light Beige squares.
- Place the Light Beige squares on the Dark Brown squares, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line. Cut on the line. Press open. You should have 12 HST squares at 2 1/2" each.

Half-Square Rectangle (HSR) Squares

- Use the 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles.
- Place the Light Beige rectangles on the Dark Brown rectangles, right sides together and stitch. Press open. You should have 4 HSR squares at 2 1/2" each.

Assemble by following the picture.

NOTE: I pressed most of the seams open to help reduce bulk since there are so many intersections.
