

## SANTIAM SCRAPPERS BOM for December, 2004

### MIDNIGHT STAR (12" x 12" Finished Size)



#### Dark Red (DR)

- 2 1/2" square – Cut 8
- 1 7/8" square – Cut 5

#### Dark Green (DG)

- 2 1/2" square – Cut 8
- 5 1/4" square – Cut 2

#### Medium Gold (MG)

- 5 1/4" square – Cut 2
- 1 7/8" square – Cut 4

NOTE: All squares need to be 4 1/2" (4" finished). Be sure to measure and trim as needed before assembling the block.

#### Quarter Square Triangle Squares

- Draw 2 diagonal lines from corner to corner on the Gold 5 1/4" squares to form an "X." Place 1 Gold 5 1/4" square on 1 Green 5 1/4" square, right sides together. For 1 of the drawn lines only, stitch 1/4" from the line on both sides of the line. Do not stitch the other drawn line. Cut on the unstitched line first, then cut on the line you stitched on both sides of. Press open (towards Green) to form 4 half square triangles (HST) (2 Gold/Green, 2 Green/Gold).
- Place the Gold/Green HSTs on the Green/Gold HSTs, right sides together to form 4 Green/Gold/Green/Gold 4 1/2" QST squares. Stitch 1/4" seam. I pressed the seam open to reduce bulk.

#### Corner Four-Patch

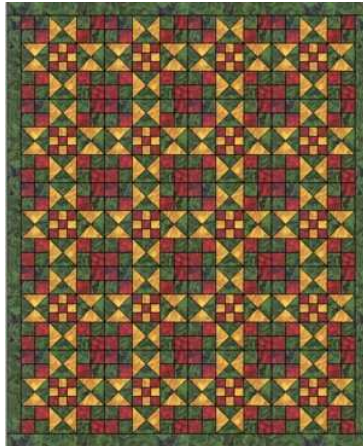
Sew two Red 2 1/2" squares and two Green 2 1/2" squares into a four-patch 4 1/2" square as shown in picture. Press towards Green. Make 4 of these four-patch squares.

#### Center Nine-Patch

Sew five Red 1 7/8" squares and four (2) Gold 1 7/8" squares into a nine-patch 4 1/2" square as shown in picture. Press towards Red.

Assemble as shown in the picture.
