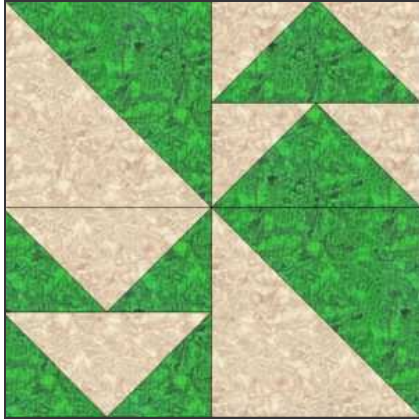


SANTIAM SCRAPPERS BOM for March, 2005

Woven Emeralds

(12" x 12" Finished Size)



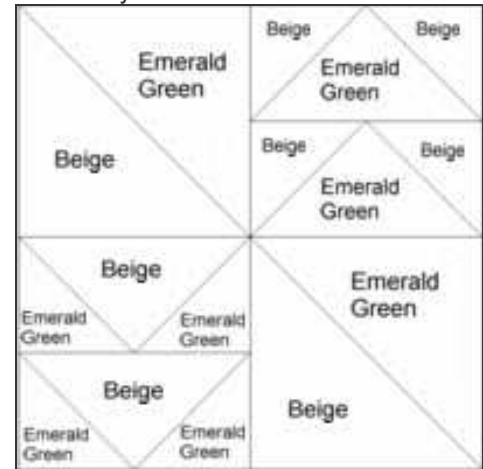
Beige

- 6 7/8" square – Cut 1
- 3 1/2" square – Cut 4
- 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle – Cut 2

Emerald Green

- 6 7/8" square – Cut 1
- 3 1/2" square – Cut 4
- 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle – Cut 2

Color Key:



Half Square Triangle (HST) Squares

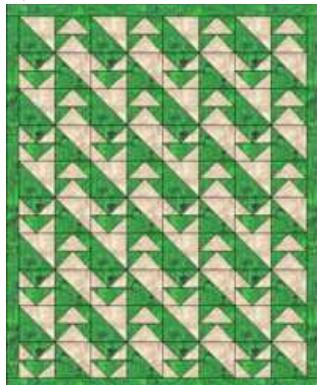
Draw 1 diagonal line from 1 corner to the opposite corner on the Beige 6 7/8" square. Place 1 Beige 6 7/8" square on 1 Emerald Green 6 7/8" square, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" from the drawn line on both sides of the line. Cut on the line. Press open to form 2 Beige/Emerald Green 6 1/2" HST squares.

Flying Geese Rectangles

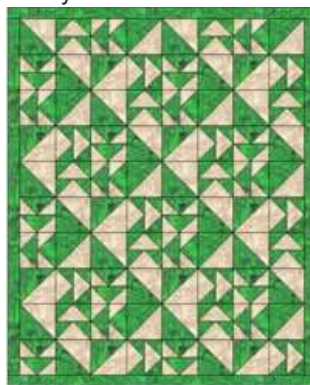
Draw 1 diagonal line from 1 corner to the opposite corner on each Beige 3 1/2" square and on each Emerald Green 3 1/2" square (8 squares total). Place 1 Beige 3 1/2" square on 1 end of an Emerald Green 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle. Stitch ON the drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Place 1 Beige 3 1/2" square on the other end of the Emerald Green 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle. Be sure the drawn line goes in the direction as shown in the picture. Stitch ON the drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. You should now have 1 Flying Geese rectangle. Repeat this for the remaining 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles using the Beige 3 1/2" squares with the Emerald Green 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, and the Emerald Green 3 1/2" squares with the Beige 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Stitch the 2 Beige/Emerald Green Flying Geese rectangles together as shown in the picture to form a 6 1/2" square. Stitch the 2 Emerald Green/Beige Flying Geese rectangles together as shown in the picture to form a 6 1/2" square. Stitch the 2 Flying Geese 6 1/2" squares to the 2 HST 6 1/2" squares as shown in the picture to complete the block.
