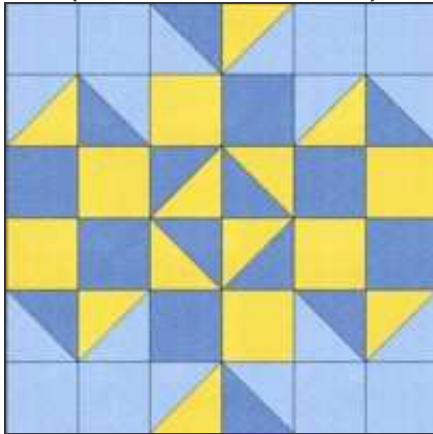

What the Hay?

(12" x 12" Finished Size)



Light Blue

- 2 1/2" Squares - Cut 8
- 2 7/8" Squares - Cut 6

Dark Blue

- 2 1/2" Squares - Cut 6
- 2 7/8" Squares - Cut 5

Medium Yellow

- 2 1/2" Squares - Cut 6
- 2 7/8" Squares - Cut 5

Half-Square Triangle Squares

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner on 3 of the Light Blue 2 7/8" squares.
Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner on 5 of the Medium Yellow 2 7/8" squares.

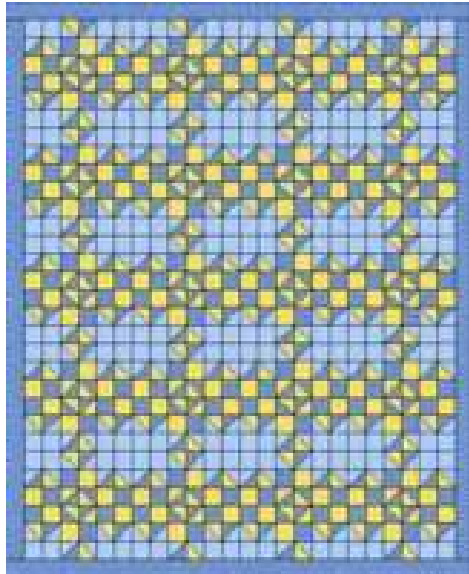
Place the 3 Light Blue 2 7/8" squares on 3 Dark Blue 2 7/8" squares, right sides together.
Place 2 of the Medium Yellow 2 7/8" squares on 2 Dark Blue 2 7/8" squares, right sides together.
Place 3 of the Medium Yellow 2 7/8" squares on the remaining 3 Light Blue 2 7/8" squares, right sides together.

For the 8 pairs of 2 7/8" squares, stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Press open to form 16 half-square triangle squares, 2 1/2" each. You should have:

- 6 Light Blue/Dark Blue 2 1/2" squares
- 4 Medium Yellow/Dark Blue 2 1/2" squares
- 6 Medium Yellow/Light Blue 2 1/2" squares

Sew together the 2 1/2" squares as shown in the picture.
